Thamesdown Transport Current Bus Routes

For people who do not wish to go into the centre of Swindon to change buses, it is currently possible to take the Number 2 Covingham and Nythe bus route and change at Walcot with approximately a 100 metre walk across the road to join the Eldene bus route, Number 13 / 14 which then stops close to Eldene Health Centre.

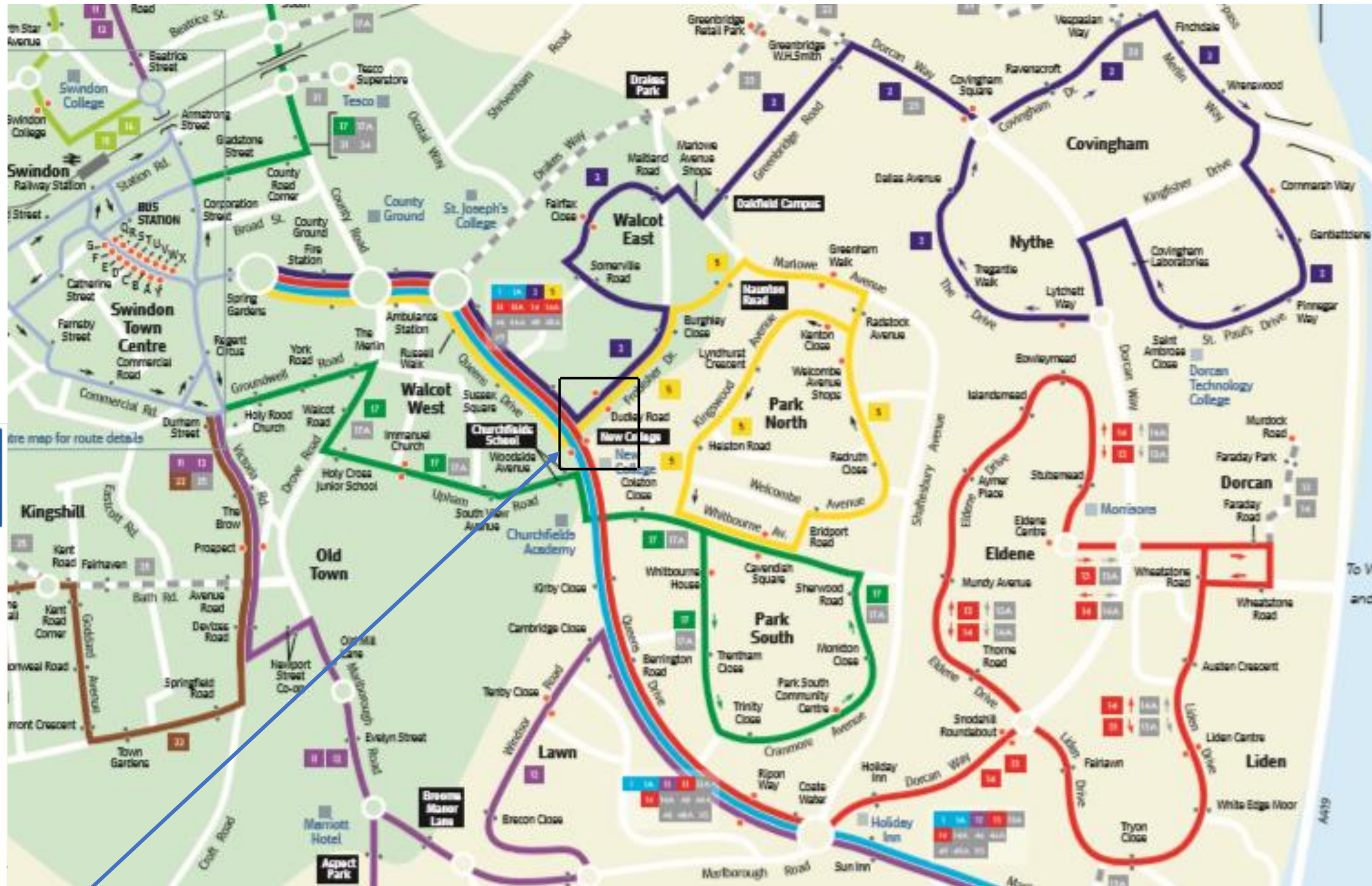
The frequency of both these bus routes is every 10-15 minutes, Monday to Friday daytime.
